### Project Background

In April 2010, the Ateneo de Manila University - School of Government and the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (The Bank) entered into a grant agreement to support the third year of operations of the Affiliated Network for Social Accountability in East Asia and the Pacific (ANSA-EAP). The Grant is made from the Bank's FY2010 Development Grant Facility (DGF) Window 2, with the amount of one million two hundred fifty thousand United States dollars (US\$ 1.25 million).

### Project Goal

The Grant will continue to support the following objectives:

1. support the consolidation of and ongoing operations of the Affiliated Network for Social Accountability-East Asia Pacific (ANSA-EAP);
2. develop cross-country collaboration on social accountability and support initiatives to strengthen the demand for good governance;
3. provide technical assistance to different countries so the quality of social accountability initiatives is greatly enhanced;
4. deliver training programs on specific social accountability tools and techniques; and
5. share country experiences and lessons from social accountability and demand-side governance initiatives regionally and globally.

6. Resource Mobilization.
