The Temasek Foundation National University of Singapore (NUS) Leadership Enrichment and Regional Networking (LEaRN) Programme for Semester 1 (August to December 2015) is now open for applications. Aimed at grooming bright young Asian leaders from the region, the program has a unique twin objective of developing a global outlook through overseas studies combined with active community involvement and contribution to social causes.

The Ateneo de Manila University is asked to nominate a total of ten (10) undergraduate students from the Loyola Schools. Each scholarship is valued at SGD 6,500 and this is aimed at subsidizing the student's airfare, accommodation, books and living expenses. The study period will be from August to December 2015. For AY 2015/2016, the TF LEaRN Programme will run for one semester only, in semester 1 (August to December 2015), instead of semester 1 and 2 as per Temasek Foundation's request.
